All-State takes place in Eugene, at the Hilton Conference Center, Hult Center for the Performing Arts, The Shedd, First Baptist Church and the University of Oregon. Students were selected on the bases of their performance on their auditions.

We appreciate all of your work and your dedication to your students and to music education. This event is the backbone of OMEA's efforts to provide quality experiences for music students and professional development for music educators. Our success or failure is greatly dependant on you and your efforts! This email includes the essential information you need to provide to your students and your students' parents. We also included the email we sent to your principal.

**Registration Deadline is November 4<sup>th</sup>:** Please direct your student's parents to <http://www.oregonmusic.org/> to **register by midnight on November 4<sup>th</sup>**. The fee for participation is \$285. This fee covers clinician costs, sheet music, food, lodging, shuttle busses, rehearsal and performance space rentals, chaperones and all of the other expenses associated with All-State. If a student is **not going to participate**, contact the All-State manger so an alternate can be selected.

**Parent Payments:** If the parents are paying for their child; **payments must be made online through PayPal**. Parents do NOT need to have or create a PayPal account they can use a credit card. **If the school is paying All-State fees parents still have to register students online by midnight on November 4, 2011.**

**School Payments:** If your school covers the fees for your student please arrange for a purchase order, or check to be sent to: OMEA, All-State, PO Box 1235, La Grande, OR, 97850.

- 1. List all of the students that the school is paying for with that check or purchase order**
- 2. School payments are due in the office by November 14<sup>th</sup>**
- 3. If we do not have payment by the 11/14 deadline your student will be dropped from All-State**
- 4. If the school pays you still have to register students online by midnight on November 4, 2011**

You must be registered for the Conference on-line for your student to participate. You are responsible for your student should they require assistance during the conference. You must also be a current member to register. Register on-line at <http://www.oregonmusic.org/conference-registration-events.html>. You need to registrar for the conference **by midnight November 4<sup>th</sup>**. You do not have to pay for the conference at the time of registration. You can select "Pay later" and send a check or purchase order to the office or bring a check or purchase order to the conference.

The **music for All-State will be sent to you** for distribution. If your student has paid and you have not received your student's music by December 1<sup>st</sup> please contact the group manager.

The All-State group managers, have worked hard to provide your child with an excellent conductor and they have developed a well-balanced ensemble. Students were selected on the bases of their performance on their auditions. All-State takes place in Eugene, at the Hilton Conference Center, Hult Center for the Performing Arts, and the University of Oregon. It is an honor for them to be selected to play or sing with a nationally-renowned conductor and other advanced players. If your child is **not** going to participate, contact their teacher and send an email to their group manager as alternates are eager to fill the position your child holds!

**We need you to go to our website <http://www.oregonmusic.org/> and register your student by November 4th.** The fee for participation is \$285. Fee covers clinician costs, sheet music, food, lodging, shuttle busses, rehearsal and performance space rentals, chaperones and all other expenses associated with All-State. Payments must be made online using PayPal– you do NOT need to have or create a PayPal account you can use a credit card. If your students' school covers the fees for your student please select "Purchase Order" or "School Check", rather than "Pay Now". **If the school is paying All-State fees you still have to register your child online by midnight on November 4, 2011.**

**School Payments:** Consult with your student's music director to see if the school is planning on paying for All-State. If so make sure that they send a school check or purchase order payable to OMEA prior to November 14<sup>th</sup>. If we do not have a payment from your student's school prior to November 14<sup>th</sup> your student will be dropped from All-State.

**Refunds:** Refunds are made on a case by case base. No refunds shall be made without a letter from your physician, and/or parent/guardian for family emergencies. \$100.00 handling fee will be retained to help cover our costs.

**Music:** The music for this event will be sent to your student's music director for distribution. If your student has not received their music by December 1<sup>st</sup> please contact your All-State manager.

You will need to make sure that your child eats lunch as they will not eat until dinner.

This fee covers clinician costs, sheet music, food, lodging, shuttle busses, rehearsal and performance space rentals, chaperones and all other costs associated with All-State.

We would love you to attend your student's performance. If you bring this letter to the box office we will give you a free ticket to your student's performance! ## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR HIGH SCHOOL ALL-STATE HONOR GROUP MEMBERS:

1. **COME PREPARED:** You accepted that responsibility when you accepted the invitation to participate.
2. **DO NOT FORGET YOUR MUSIC!** Band & Orchestra students need to bring a music stand. Choir students need to bring black music folders.
3. **REMEMBER YOUR CONCERT CLOTHES!** Concert gear should be on a **sturdy hanger, bagged and labeled** with your name, honor group name and high school. Bring what you wear for your school concerts.
4. **REGISTRATION: Jazz, Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band and Orchestra** register at the Hilton Hotel, 66 East 6th Avenue, Eugene, OR 97401 (541) 342-2000 **prior to going to your rehearsal site.**  
**REGISTRATION: Mixed Choir** register at the Valley River Inn, 1000 Valley River Way Eugene, OR 97401-2115 (541) 743-1000 **prior to going to your rehearsal site. Do not come to the rehearsal with luggage!**
5. **REFUNDS:** Refunds are made on a case by case base. No refunds shall be made without a letter from your physician, and/or parent/guardian for family emergencies. \$100.00 handling fee will be retained.
6. **AUDITIONS AND TESTING:** There will be chair auditions for orchestra members. Decisions about other chair assignments have been left to the screeners and managers; there will be some auditions for solo parts. Choir members will be tested in quartets and music must be nearly memorized. Unprepared students may be sent home (see refund policy).
7. **MEALS:** All-State student **meals have been pre-paid.** Do not plan to go out to eat as there is no time.
8. **STAY WITH YOUR GROUP:** Do not leave the Rehearsal Site except for meal breaks if you walk to the meal site.
9. **PARKING/SHUTTLES:** Parking in many of the rehearsal sites is nearly impossible to find. Vehicles parked longer than the posted time will be ticketed. OMEA-provides shuttles to rehearsals and to the designated hotels.
10. **ATTENDANCE will be checked at the start of each rehearsal.** Be on time for all rehearsals. If you become ill, you must communicate this to the site manager or the All-State manager.
11. **NAME TAGS must** be worn at all times.
12. **ROOM ASSIGNMENTS: Do not ask to switch rooms.** It is a huge job to get all of you in rooms. Every effort will be made to accommodate your wishes for roommates as indicated on your registration forms.
13. **HOTEL COURTESY: Please be quiet in the hallways of the hotel.**
14. **HOTEL PHONES: Do not use the phone in your room for calls which have a charge.** Use cell phones, or pay phones in the lobby and call collect or use a prepaid phone card. Your **school will be charged for any and all billable charges to your room.**
15. **TICKETS:** Tickets for the concert will be on sale daily at the Hult Center Box Office. Tickets are \$15. Tickets at the Hult Center are available by calling 541.682.5000, Tues-Fri 12-5 p.m., Sat 11-3, and after 12 Noon the day of the concert.
16. **HOTEL CHECKOUT:** You must check out of your room **by 12:00 noon, Sunday.** A room will be provided for luggage storage. **Dress in your concert outfits prior to checkout unless you have been directed not to by your All-State manager.**
17. **REPORTING FOR CONCERT:** Participants will be instructed where to report for the concert by your organizing chairs. A room will be provided for storage of cases and coats. Do not leave purses or other valuables in this room. All-State Orchestra members will report directly to the Silva Concert Hall stage.
18. **AFTER YOUR GROUP PERFORMS:** you will be directed to an area of the concert hall to hear the rest of the concert. **You will be told where and when to get personal things from the storage room at the Hilton prior to your concert.**

**IMPORTANT:** Please bring only what is necessary for your trip to Eugene - Extra luggage increases the likelihood of lost personal belongings. You will be sharing luggage space at times with 700 other people.
