Dear Honor Group Student:

We are very pleased that you have been selected to participate in this year's OMEA Honor Groups. We know that this experience will remain with you as a positive and pleasant memory for many years to come.

### **WHAT TO BRING**

Music, pencil, water bottle, between-meal snacks, personal hygiene items, sleeping bag (optional), any necessary medication, a folding music stand (band/orchestra).

### **WHAT TO WEAR**

MS/Elementary Groups: Concert attire will consist of a uniform T-shirt (provided), to be worn with black pants or skirt, dark shoes, and dark socks. (No tennis shoes, please.)

HS Band/Orchestra: Concert Black Attire

HS Choir: Wear your concert attire from your home school.

We request that students wear comfortable, appropriate clothes during rehearsals and the course of the honor group activities. Hats may not be worn indoors. Please do not bring expensive jewelry, irreplaceable items, or clothing with inappropriate slogans.

### **CONCERT TICKETS**

MS/Elementary Groups: The Elementary concert is free. The Middle School concert is \$10. Tickets are available at the door.

HS Band/Orchestra/Choir: Tickets to All-State concerts are \$20 onsite at conference registration. You may purchase tickets in advance through TicketsWest <http://ticketswest.rdln.com> (\$3.50 fee per ticket). Tickets will be sold for \$25 at the door. Children grade 8 and below admitted free, no ticket needed. There will be a single ticket for the three concerts held simultaneously at 4:15. One ticket will be good for any or all of them—attendees can move between concerts as desired.

### **RECORDINGS/PHOTOGRAPHS**

Recording devices (including video) are not allowed in the concert hall. We also ask that there be no flash photographs taken during the session/concert. An official sound recording will be made of the concert, and a professional photographer will take a group photo. Families may order CDs or photographs by completing and mailing the forms enclosed with your music.

### **MUSIC**

Your music will be sent to your music teacher the first week of December. Please keep it in good condition. Music is to be turned in immediately following your performance. Percussion parts have been highlighted as to what part you must practice. Please have your music practiced and additional fingerings marked before the first rehearsal. Always have a sharpened pencil prepared for rehearsal markings. Seating will allow you the opportunity to meet as many new people as possible. This is intended to be a friendly and non-competitive ensemble.
